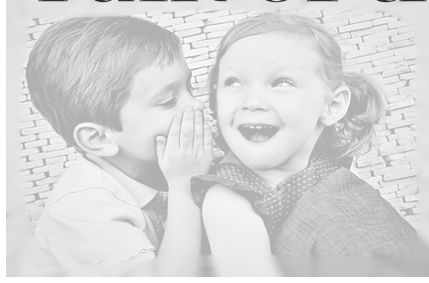

Halloween Safety Tips

Safety Tips for Drivers:



- **Be Alert**
 - Trick-or-Treaters might be walking on roads, may come out suddenly from behind bushes, parked vehicles, or large lawn decorations
 - Reduce any distractions while driving
- **Slow Down**
 - Halloween sees a lot more pedestrians and slower traffic patterns, driving slower helps you be more mindful and makes for shorter break time and distance

Safety Tips for Pedestrians:

- **Be Alert**
 - As an adult with Trick-or-Treaters under your care be mindful of...
 - where are they
 - what costumes are they wearing
 - are they near roads
- **Practice Caution**
 - Encourage young Trick-or-Treaters to use the "Buddy System" and look both ways before crossing
 - If your trick-or-treaters are out with someone else, do you have the accompanying adult's phone number
