### **Pembroke Flag Committee**

Would you like to honor a service member? How about adopting a service member's flag?

The American Legion Flag Committee is offering the opportunity to purchase a flag to honor a service member. The fee for a new service member cross and flag is \$100 for the first year, then \$10.00 for each year after. The \$10.00 covers any maintenance for the cross, metal pole, and/or flag due to natural disasters and weather. Your flag will be replaced every five years, even if it isn't damaged.

If you don't have a service member to honor, there's also an option to adopt an abandoned flag. For just \$10.00 per year, you will help honor a service member who was willing to risk their life to defend our nation.
