Trash Can Changes

Beginning this month, there will be a few changes in reference to solid waste within the city. All trash cans must belong to 'Allgreen' services for trash to be picked up. If you do not have a trash can from Allgreen, please call City Hall and request one.

Additionally, if you place your cans at the curb the day prior to pick up they aren't to be put out before 5pm on that day. They must also be pulled back from the curb by 8am the following day.

Finally, garbage rates for both residential and commercial will be increasing. Residential will increase from \$13/month to \$15.50 and Commercial will increase from \$16/month to \$18.



Water/Sewer Rates

Beginning in March, customers will notice an increase in water and sewer rates. Both rates will increase by five 5%.


